IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows;

- 1. A preservation order is granted with respect to the following;
 - a. The balance of MK11, 353, 516.03 in account number 9271763065014, in the name of Double J Investment, at MyBucks Bank, Blantyre Branch.
- 2. The said property shall be brought under the control of the Director General of the Financial Intelligence Authority (who is the administrator of the confiscation fund on behalf of the Minister in terms of section 130 (2) of the Financial Crimes Act) until the expiration of the period prescribed under section 67 of the Financial Crimes Act or until the conclusion of the forfeiture proceedings instituted herein.
- 3. The Claimant shall cause this preservation order to be published in the Government Gazette or two newspapers of the widest circulation within 21 days of this order.
- 4. The Defendants or any interested third party wishing to oppose this order to file their notice in terms of section 66 of the Financial Crimes Act.
